On a private farm between Robertson and Ashton. 11km from Robertson and 4km before Ashton on R60. GPS Coordinates: -33.83922, 20.01266

R150pp is valid for the whole weekend. No day passes.

How does camping work on the weekend?

Camping is allowed in designated camping areas only. Bring your own tent, caravan, camp trailer etc. There are Camp Commanders who can assist with queries. Regrettably, no camping sites may be reserved.

A designated disabled camping block is available

Can I braai at the campsite?

NO open fires in the camping area (including a weber). ONLY Gas cooking equipment may be used within the camping areas. However, there will be a few communal and regulated bonfire areas where fires & open flame braais will be permitted. Bring your own grid, braais, wood and tools. Some wood will be provided and also sold at vendors.

Do I need to book my own accommodation or will it be provided?

You can choose to camp outdoors on the farm, free of charge, or you can book the glamping option at an additional fee. Only limited spots left. Book online on the website. Coming soon.

Will there be ablution facilities?

Cold water showering facilities will be available and a few hot showers (that operate 06:00 - 22:00, except during speaker sessions) in the General Camp areas. You may bring your portable shower which can be erected at your campsite. Temporary toilet facilities will be available. Please take note that you need to bring your own toilet paper.

What time can we start arriving at the campsite to pitch tents?

From Thursday afternoon, 25 September 2025.

Observe TOTAL silence from 11pm to 5am. Please respect and obey this rule.

Will food be available at the conference?

Food and beverage vendors will be available in a dedicated area where you can buy take-aways from vendors that will operate during non-programme times. You are allowed to bring in your own food, but please support.

How do I pay for items at the event?

There will be a Standard Bank ATM. Each vendor will have an electronic card machine and cash operated. To know what type of vendors there will be, follow us on the Mighty Men Western Cape event page.

Is there water available?

Terrain water is safe for cooking and washing only. Bring your own fresh drinking water or purchase bottled water from the vendor area.

Is there electricity available?

No electricity points at campsites. Bring your own powerbanks and car chargers for your cell phones and solar or battery-operated night lights. There will be lights at night around the ablution blocks and communal braai areas.

Will there be emergency services available at the venue?

Medical staff will be on duty with ambulances that will be on standby.

Will there be Mighty Men Branded clothing for sale? Caps, shirts etc?

Merchandise is sold before the event and will continue throughout the year for men, women, and kids. There will be an MM tent, selling caps, beanies, keychains, and faith-inspired wristbands. Angus Buchan bibles and books.

Kids u/18 must be accompanied by an adult. Due to the nature of the event and speaker sessions, we advise no u/9's to avoid any disturbances. School or church youth groups are advised to contact the organiser before the event.

NO WOMEN ALLOWED on Friday and Saturday.
